<u>CSSC-03-01</u> Seismic Safety Bond Act of 2004	Submitted to Legislative Counsel	Authorizes the issuance of up to \$700 million in state general obligation bonds to provide funds – on a 75:25 matching basis – for the retrofit and reconstruction of local government (essential services) buildings.	Staff is working with Assemblymember Liu’s office for authorship.
<u>CSSC-03-02</u> Design-Build Contracting for K-12 School Construction Projects	Submitted to Legislative Counsel	Conform the standards applicable to K-12 school construction projects with the new community college contracting standards for design-build projects. These new standards strengthen the role and independence of the Inspector of Record to ensure adherence to seismic safety standards.	Staff is working with Senator Alarcon’s office for authorship.
<u>CSSC-03-03</u> Mandatory Water Heater Strapping for Rental Residential Units.	Submitted to Legislative Counsel	Requires the owners of rental housing units to brace (strap) the water heaters in each existing unit by July 1, 2005.	Staff is working with Assemblymember Calderon’s office for authorship.
<u>CSSC-03-04</u> School Safety and Preparedness	Pending	Requires periodic inspections of school facilities by local fire service personnel to assess their preparedness and safety measures; Sets-up a “grading system” based on these inspections applying the checklist included in the 2002 OES report on Non-Structural Hazards in California Schools. Publish and post the school campus grade in school publications.	Staff is working with Assemblymember Corbett’s office for authorship.
